Our Origins

LDN Aware came to life as an outcome of the First International Low Dose Awareness Week (ILDNAW) October 19-25, 2009.

The ILDNAW press releases were quickly picked-up by news organizations and websites worldwide, which lead to several interviews and hundreds of inquiries regarding LDN. This success lead us to think how all the information on LDN is scattered across many websites and that people often learn about LDN in a haphazard way. As LDN advocates, we have been frustrated by the slow pace of LDN recognition by the mainstream medical community in most countries. The status quo of doctors, institutions, corporations and governments present many obstacles to learning about and acquiring LDN.

What if we could get everyone, around the world, better focused on

LDN awareness? While each country and culture present unique challenges for gaining LDN recognition, we all share a common desire to spread the word of this remarkable drug.

We started with creating the LDN Aware logo. The graphic of the LDN Aware logo symbolizes increasing energy. Like an ocean wave, a spiral galaxy, a Nautilus shell, a hurricane, the LDN spiral is a visual statement of how by working together we can achieve greater results than by working alone. Our colors, green and blue, represent how LDN works to compliment the elegant nature of our body's immune system.

LDN Aware is your website. It was created to capture the great work of many dedicated people all in one place. Technically structured to take full advantage of how internet search engines work, the more people who visit LDN Aware the higher it will

be placed on search engine pages.
